



2021-2022 Application Checklist

Like many independent schools in the Puget Sound region, Epiphany School uses a common application through Puget Sound Independent Schools (PSIS). To begin the process, first fill out the inquiry form at epiphanyschool.org/inquire. Then log in to your Epiphany School Admissions Progress page to submit application materials and register for a tour, open house, interview, and student visit. To apply for the 2022-2023 school year, be sure to complete the following before the January 13, 2022 admission deadline.
