

## **Epiphany School Community Expectations**

Epiphany School's faculty, staff, and Board of Trustees pledge to do everything we can to help your child(ren) and family stay healthy during the COVID-19 pandemic. Our robust campus-wide health and safety plan includes grade-level cohorts of students and teachers, physical changes to our classrooms, bathrooms, and public spaces, advanced cleaning schedules and equipment, and more.

Minimizing the risk of transmission requires partnership, trust, and open communication between our school and our families. To that end, we ask that every Epiphany School family enrolled in the 2021-2022 school year signal their personal commitment to our shared goal of keeping our community healthy by signing this document.

During this time, it is especially important that all of us stay vigilant and do our part by practicing—**both on and off campus**—key protocols known to reduce the spread of COVID-19, including:

- Wearing a mask at all times while on campus, whether indoors or out, unless an accommodation is requested and indicated
- Prior to the start of school, completing Epiphany School's vaccination certification form for everyone in your household over the age of 12 who may come onto campus this school year (only vaccinated people can enter school buildings)
- Adhering to WA DOH and CDC guidance while off campus, including masking, group gathering, and travel (see <a href="here">here</a> for guidance for fully vaccinated people; see <a href="here">here</a> for guidance for unvaccinated people, including those under age 12)
- Vaccinating your child when a vaccine becomes available for their age group, or submitting exemption documentation
- Screening your child every morning for <u>COVID-19 symptoms</u> and keeping them home if they are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms
- Notifying the school by emailing <a href="health@epiphanyschool.org">health@epiphanyschool.org</a> if any member of your household or social circle has any COVID-19 symptoms
- Staying informed about Epiphany School's ongoing expectations, protocols, and practices by reading all communications from school staff
- Following all COVID-19 testing and quarantining protocols as outlined in Epiphany School's online <u>Health</u> & Safety Information Page

Epiphany School staff will be adhering to these community expectations and we ask you to join us.
