

Epiphany School Community Expectations

Epiphany School's faculty, staff, and Board of Trustees pledge to do everything we can to help your child(ren) and family stay healthy during the COVID-19 pandemic. We have developed a robust plan for campus-wide health and safety, which includes small cohorts of students and teachers, expanded digital learning resources, advanced cleaning schedules and equipment, physical changes to our classrooms, bathrooms, and public spaces, and more.

Minimizing the risk of transmission requires partnership, trust, and open communication between our school and our families. To that end, we ask that every Epiphany School family enrolled in the 2020-2021 school year signal their personal commitment to our shared goal of keeping our community healthy by signing this document.

During this time, it is especially important that all of us stay vigilant and do our part by practicing—both on and off campus—key protocols known to reduce the spread of COVID-19, including:

- Limiting the number of social circles you participate in
- Wearing a mask and physically distancing when outside of the home
- Providing accurate information for any health screening questions (whether on campus or off) and notifying the school if any member of your household or social circle has any <u>COVID-19 symptoms</u>
- Keeping your child home if they are sick or experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms
- Staying informed about Epiphany School's ongoing expectations, protocols, and practices by reading all
 communications from school staff
- Adhering to Washington state's latest restrictions on group gatherings and recreation
- Considering all options if traveling, such as taking a road trip rather than flying, or if flying choosing an airline that physically distances passengers and requires masks
- If your family chooses to travel at any point, following <u>CDC guidelines for best precautions</u> before, during, and after travel
- Following all COVID-19 testing and quarantining protocols as outlined in Epiphany School's online <u>Fall</u> 2020 Reopening Plan

Epiphany School staff will be adhering to these community expectations and we ask you to join us.
